## **Matthew 6:5-6**

**6 But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.**

**6 "Here's what I want you to do: Find a quiet, secluded place so you won't be tempted to role-play before God. Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace.**

## **Matthew 7:24-25**

**24 “Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock:**

**25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.**

**24–25 “These words I speak to you are not incidental additions to your life, homeowner improvements to your standard of living. They are foundational words, words to build a life on. If you work these words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who built his house on solid rock. Rain poured down, the river flooded, a tornado hit—but nothing moved that house. It was fixed to the rock. [Message]**

## **Psalm 61:1-4**

**1 Hear my cry, O God;  
Attend to my prayer.**

**2 From the end of the earth I will cry to You,  
When my heart is overwhelmed;  
Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.**

**3 For You have been a shelter for me,  
A strong tower from the enemy.**

**4 I will abide in Your tabernacle forever;  
I will trust in the shelter of Your wings.**

**Psalm 119:114-117**

**114 You are my hiding place and my shield;  
I hope in Your word.**

**115 Depart from me, you evildoers,  
For I will keep the commandments of my God!**

**116 Uphold me according to Your word, that I may live;  
And do not let me be ashamed of my hope.**

**117 Hold me up, and I shall be safe,  
And I shall observe Your statutes continually.**

## **Psalm 119:169-172**
