How Can We Know The Way?

John 14:2b-6

2 I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

4 And where I go you know, and the way you know.”

5 Thomas said to Him, “Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?”

6 Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Matthew 26:39

39 Then he walked a short distance away, and overcome with grief, he threw himself facedown on the ground and prayed, “My Father, if there is any way you can deliver me from this suffering, please take it from me. Yet what I want is not important, for I only desire to fulfill your plan for me.”

Then an angel from heaven appeared to strengthen him. [TPT]

1 Timothy 2:3-6

3 This is good and pleases God our Savior,

4 who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.

5 For there is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus.

6 He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time.

Job 9:32-35

**32 “For He is not a man, as I am,
That I may answer Him,
And that we should go to court together.**

**33 Nor is there any mediator between us,
Who may lay his hand on us both.**

**34 Let Him take His rod away from me,
And do not let dread of Him terrify me.**

**35 Then I would speak and not fear Him,
But it is not so with me.**

Hebrews 4:15-16

15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

1 John 2:1-2

1 My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous.

2 He himself is the sacrifice that atones for our sins—and not only our sins but the sins of all the world.

Show Us The Father
And We Will Be Satisfied

John 14:8-11

8 Philip said to Him, “Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us.”

9 Jesus said to him, “Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? **He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’?”**

10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

11 **Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.**

Isaiah 53:2b

**He has no form or comeliness;
And when we see Him,
There is no beauty that we should desire Him. [NKJ]**

**There was nothing beautiful or majestic about his appearance,
nothing to attract us to him. [NLT]**

**There was nothing attractive about him,
nothing to cause us to take a second look. [Message]**

John 1:1-2, 14

1 In the beginning the Word already existed.

**The Word was with God,
and the Word was God.**

2 He existed in the beginning with God.

14 So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father's one and only Son.

Philippians 2:6-8

**6 Though he (Jesus) was God,
he did not think of equality with God
as something to cling to.**

**7 Instead, he gave up his divine privileges;
he took the humble position of a slave
and was born as a human being.
When he appeared in human form,**

**8 he humbled himself in obedience to God
and died a criminal's death on a cross.**

John 17:4-5

**4 I have glorified you on the earth
by faithfully doing everything you've told me to do.**

**5 So my Father, restore me back to the glory
that we shared together when we were face-to-face
before the universe was created.” [TPT]**

**How Will You Manifest Yourself To Us &
Not The World?**

John 14:21-23, 26

21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him.”

22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, “Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?”

23 Jesus answered and said to him, “If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

John 14:21, 23

21 The person who has My commands and keeps them is the one who [really] loves Me; and whoever [really] loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I [too] will love him and will show (reveal, manifest) Myself to him. [I will let Myself be clearly seen by him and make Myself real to him.]

23 Jesus answered, If a person [really] loves Me, he will keep My word [obey My teaching]; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home (abode, special dwelling place) with him.

[Amplified]

Mark 12:30-31

30 And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment.

31 And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

1 John 4:19-21

19 We love Him because He first loved us.

20 If someone says, “I love God,” and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?

21 And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.

John 16:13-15

13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

15 All things that the Father has are Mine. Therefore I said that He will take of Mine and declare it to you.

Ephesians 4:29-32

29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

31 Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice.

32 And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.
