Ephesians 1:16-19a

16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers:

17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,

18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe

Romans 8:30-32

30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

Romans 8:35, 38-39

35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

God's Faithfulness To You

2 Timothy 2:13

13 If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful, for he cannot deny who he is. [NLT]

13 But even if we are faithless, he will still be full of faith, for he never wavers in his faithfulness to us! [TPT]

13 If we are faithless [do not believe and are untrue to Him], He remains true (faithful to His Word and His righteous character), for He cannot deny Himself. [AMP]

Matthew 26:33-35, Luke 22:32

33 Then Peter spoke up and said, "Even if all the rest lose their faith and fall away, I will still be beside you, Jesus!"

34 "Are you sure, Peter?" Jesus said. "In fact, before the rooster crows a few hours from now, you will have denied me three times."

35 Peter replied, "I absolutely will never deny you, even if I have to die with you!" And all the others said the same thing.

32 But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren."

Romans 8:33-34

33 Who then would dare to accuse those whom God has chosen in love to be his? God himself is the judge who has issued his final verdict over them— "Not guilty!"
